

# **Rules Of The Race**

- No motors
- Not over 4 feet wide
- Not over 10 feet long
- Used materials only, no boughten materials unless its fasteners (Screws, bolts ect.)
- No steel wheels, can't hurt the pavement or other people
- Can't be built dangerous, no spikes or intentionally built to hurt anyone
- 0 tolerance for drugs and alcohol

## **Carts Musts:**

- Must have breaks
- Be made from recycled materials
- Must have a minimum of 3 wheels
- Must have steering

## **Racers Musts:**

- Must wear A helmet
- Racer can pad their suit or costume, or wear other additional safety equipment with the helmet (not a must but is suggested)
- Racer must be register at least one week prior to race
- Must fill out waiver prior to racing
- Signed Parental Permission form for racers under the age of 18

### **MINIMUM OF 8 YEARS OLD TO ENTER**

Inspections of carts will be done before race commences

### **AGE GROUPS**

8-15 (Youth), 16-54 (ADULTS), Freedom 55(55+/Seniors)

## **Scoring Procedure**

- Scoring will be based upon Final Speed. If you chose to dress up in a theme there will be an additional prize for Most creative for riders and carts put together.
- Judges will have a sheet containing of: name of riders/karts, if you pass the inspection, your final time and a slot for the most creative theme.
- You will be scored at the beginning, with your overall appearance of the racers/karts costumes, and build of all recycled parts. Fasteners may be new, (screws, bolts, duct tape, zip ties etc).
- You will then be scored by time. The top three of each group will receive prizes. The absolute top time in the whole race will receive their name written on a plaque fastened to a trophy.

**The Themes Must be family friendly with absolutely no sexual, racist, obscene or abusive content of ANY kind. Remember we are just here to have (good clean) fun, and watch a great new community event.**
